An examinee who believes they have been prevented from demonstrating their ability during an examination by virtue of serious medical circumstances or unanticipated exceptional circumstances beyond their control and which occurred during the examination may, within seven days after the examination has concluded, submit a compassionate appeal to the Executive Committee to void their result.

2. obtain supporting documentation, and
